## HEAD COACH RYAN BROWNLEE

Head Coach Ryan Brownlee has led Western to some memorable wins - including his first victory as a collegiate head coach against then top-ranked Arkansas in 2013. The 2014 team advanced to the Summit League Championship, the program's second straight Tournament appearance.

Coach Brownlee has had 50 players drafted that were not drafted out of High School. His 71 victories at Western Illinois rank him fourth all-time among the winningest coaches in program history.
